

Aurifil Block of the Month September 2012 ~ with Amy Ellis


Supplies:

Aurifil 12wt threads -
2145 - golden yellow
2255 - orange
1154 - red-orange

8" x 8" piece of background fabric
marking tool
embroidery hoop
needle
scissors
scraps for block border

Directions:

- 1 - Transfer the design to your background fabric, I use my window to transfer designs.
- 2 - Stitch the leaves with one strand, double weight, using a stem stitch. Use my color placement as a guide if you wish.
- 3 - Trim your stitched work to 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".
- 4 - Cut 4 rectangles 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 5 - Cut 4 rectangles 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- 6 - Sew same size rectangles together, end to end in pairs.
- 7 - Sew the smaller pair to either side of the center, press the seam allowances toward the center.
- 8 - Sew the remaining pairs to the top and bottom of the center, and press the seam allowances out.
