

## Rock Around The Clock

1. You will need:

4 solid rectangles cut at 6 1/2" X 3 1/2" each

8 squares (2) each of different fabrics cut at 5" X 5" each



2. Pair up the black floral with the salmon and the dark print with the light salmon.



3. Draw a line on the lighter fabric from corner to corner on the diagonal.



4. Sew one quarter inch away from the line on either side.



5. Cut the squares apart on the diagonal line.



6. Press to the darker side, you now have 8 half square triangles (HSTs)



7. Trim the HSTs to 3 1/2"



8. Layout the pieces as shown in the photo.



9. Now join the middle HSTs to form a pinwheel.



10. Join one HST to the solid rectangle and repeat 4 times.



11. Take one of the sewn rectangle pieces and join to the center pinwheel with a partial seam technique. Begin sewing in the middle of the rectangular piece, leaving the other part of the piece unsewn as shown in the photo.



12. Now join the next rectangle to the next side and continue until all 4 are sewn on to the center pinwheel.



13. Time to complete the partial seam. Begin sewing where the sew line starts, sew out towards the edge of the block.



14. Trim the block to 12.5 inches.
