

# Nine Patch on Point

12" x 12"

All seams 1/4"



## Cutting:

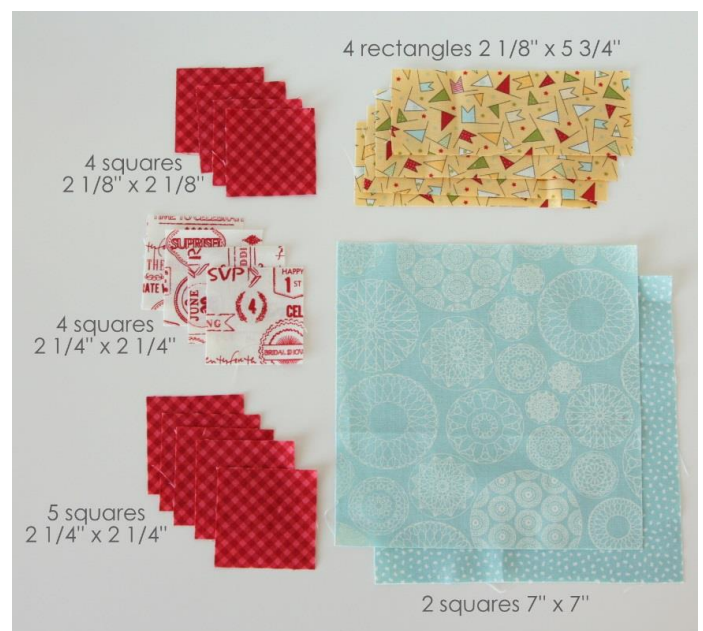
5 red squares 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"

4 white squares 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"

4 red squares 2 1/8" x 2 1/8"

4 yellow rectangles 2 1/8" x 5 3/4"

2 blue squares 7" x 7"



## Assembly:

Use 5 red 2 1/4" squares and 4 white 2 1/4" squares to create a basic 9-patch block.

Sew three rows of three squares each, alternating red and white squares.

Press seams toward the red.

Sew rows together. Press seams away from the center row.



Create two rows with a red  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " square on either side of a yellow  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle. Sew two remaining yellow rectangles to either side of the nine-patch block. Press seams toward the yellow rectangles.



Sew three rows together, pressing toward the yellow rectangles.

Cut two blue  $7$ " x  $7$ " squares once on the diagonal to create 4 blue triangles.

Center and sew long sides of two triangles to opposite sides of pieced block. Open triangles up press seams toward triangles. Center and sew remaining triangles to remaining sides of the pieced block. Press seams toward triangles.



Square up block to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
