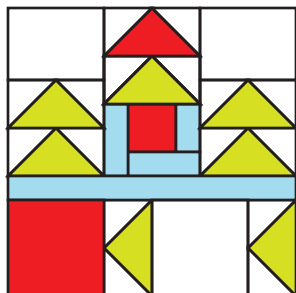


Tossed Salad

Tossed Salad is a Modern block with traditional parts. Anyway you toss it you get a fresh salad of color and dash!

All seams are 1/4" inch.

Cutting Instructions:

From Red print cut:
 1 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Square A
 1 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square B
 1 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Rectangle C

From Green solid cut:
 7 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Rectangle C

From White solid cut:
 1 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Square A
 2 - 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Rectangle D
 16 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Square B

From Blue print cut:
 1 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Rectangle E
 1 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Rectangle F
 2 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Rectangle G

Make the Geese blocks first:

1. On the wrong side of each of the White Square B's mark a line lightly with a pencil from corner to corner as shown:



2. Lay White Square B on one side of the Red Rectangle C, right sides together, and sew along the pencil line:



3. Cut away the excess corner and press White Square to the corner:



4. Repeat with another White Square B on the other side:

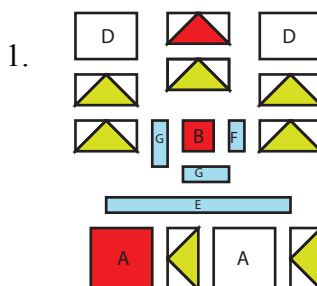


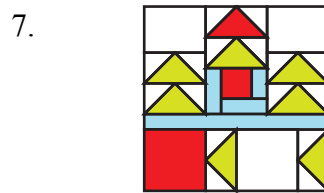
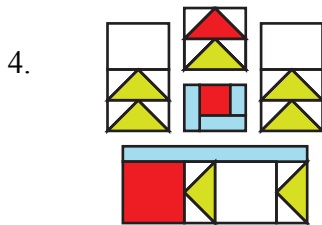
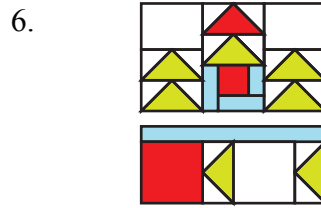
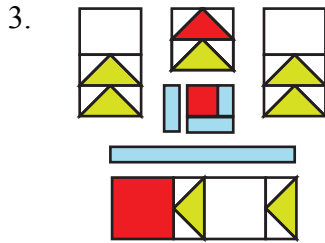
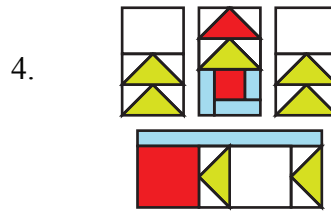
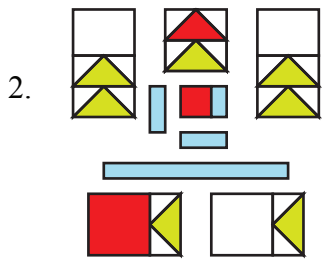
5. Repeat Steps 2-4 with the 7 Green Rectangle C's and the remaining White Square B's.



Toss your Salad Block together:

Sew the Geese blocks together with the remaining Squares and Rectangles as shown:





Here's just one sample arrangement of a few Tossed Salad blocks. Feel free to toss your salad anyway you want it. It will be delicious every time.
