



Cutting

● **Fabric A, red:**

1/2 yard.

Cut **Four** 2" squares.

Cut **Six** 1-1/2" strips, save 2 for strip piecing but subcut the others into:

Two 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangles,

Two 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangles,

Four 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles

Eight 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles,

Four 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles,

Twenty 1-1/2" squares.

Cut **Two** 2-1/4" strips for binding.

● **Fabric B, white:**

1/3 yard.

Cut **One** 2-1/2" strip, subcut into:

Eight 2-1/2" squares.

Cut **Four** 2" squares.

Cut **Three** 1-1/2" strips, save 2 for strip piecing but subcut the third one into:

Five 1-1/2" squares.

Assembly

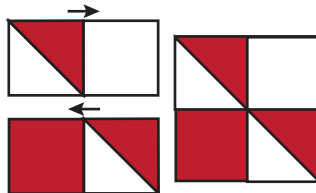
1. Center block: Make 8 half square triangles (HST):

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the white 2" squares. Layer them, right sides together, with the same size red squares.

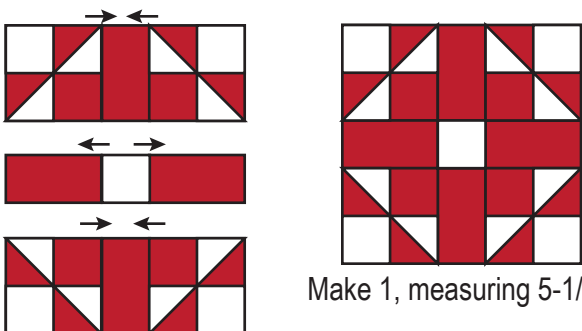


Sew a 1/4" from the line on each side, cut them apart along the drawn line and press towards the red fabric. You will get a total of 8 half square triangle units, trim them down to 1-1/2".

2. Sew a white square to 4 of the HST from step one, exactly as shown and sew a red square to the other 4 HST, exactly as shown. Press towards the squares. Sew the two units together to make 4 units as shown. Press those seams open.



3. Put the center block together as shown by sewing a red 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle between two step 2 units, making sure they are turned exactly as shown, press towards the rectangles. Then sew a white 1-1/2" square between two red 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles, pressing towards the rectangles. Then sew all 3 units together and press towards the center.



Make 1, measuring 5-1/2"

4. Corner blocks: Draw a diagonal line on the back of 16 red 1-1/2" squares.

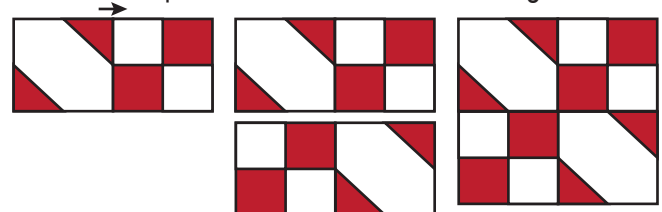
Lay a square on two opposite corners of a white 2-1/2" square, right sides together so that the drawn lines are turned as shown. Sew on the line, trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and press outwards. Make 8.



5. Sew together a white and red 1-1/2" strip and press towards the red fabric. Sub cut your strip unit into 1-1/2" wide units. You will need 16 units. Sew 2 units together into a 4-patch as shown and press the seams to one side. Make 8 4-patch units.



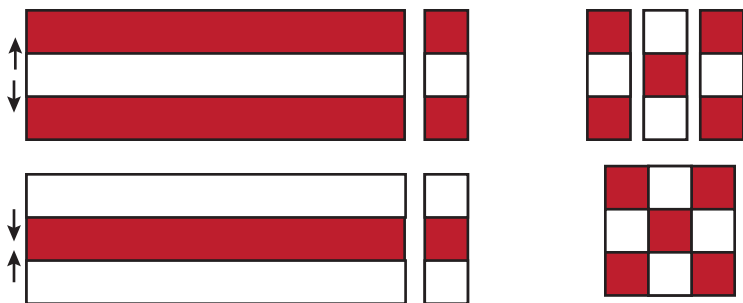
6. Sew a unit from step 4 and a 4-patch unit together exactly as shown, press towards the 4-patch. Sew 2 pairs together into the corner block and press. Make 4 blocks measuring 4-1/2".



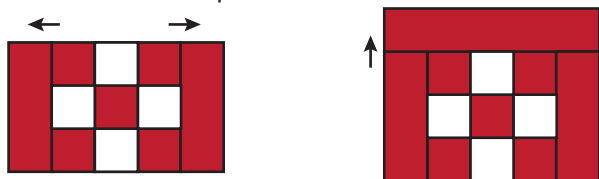
7. Side blocks: Take a white and a red 1-1/2" strips and cut them into thirds so that you have 3 strips each color that measure about 13-1/2" long. Make two strip units with 3 strips each, one with a white strip in the middle and one with a red one in the middle as shown. Press towards the red strips. Subcut your strip units into

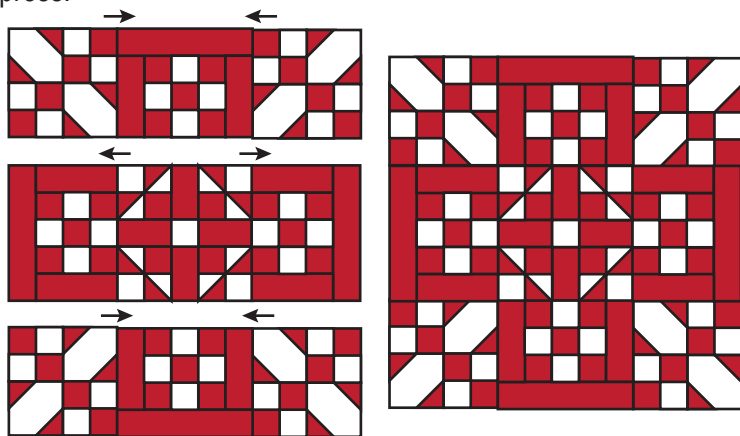
1-1/2" wide units. You will need 8 with the white in the middle and 4 with the red in the middle. Sew your units into a 9-patch as shown. Press outwards. Make four 9-patch units.



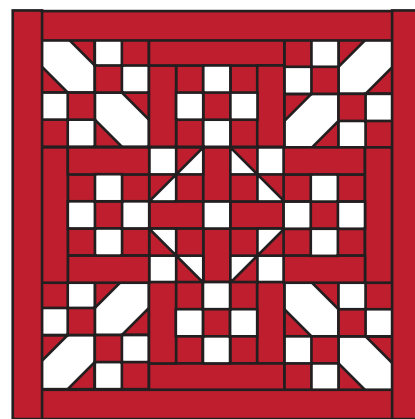
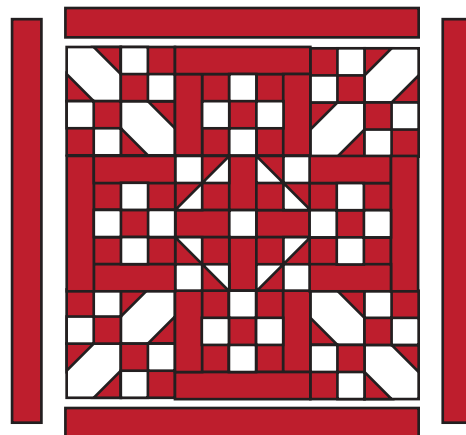
8. Sew a 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" red rectangle to each side of the 9-patch units and press outwards. Add a 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" red rectangle above the units and press.



9. Arrange all the blocks into 3 rows as shown. Make sure they are turned the right way. Sew the blocks together into rows and press towards the side blocks. Then sew the rows together and press.



10. Sew the 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangles to each side of the quilt and press. Then add the 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom and press.



11. Layer and quilt and bind:)
