This is not a difficult block to make but please read through the measurements, re-check and then cut. Measure twice, cut once as we all know too well. Cutting Directions

White

- Cut 4 strips 2" x 5 3/4"
- Cut 4 squares 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"
- Cut 8 rectangles 4" x 2 1/4"

Navy 1 Fabric - Scallop

- Cut 1 square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- Cut 4 squares 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"

Navy 2 Fabric - Stitches

- Cut 2 square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- Cut 4 squares 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"

Navy 3 Fabric - twigs blue white

- Cut 1 square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- Cut 4 squares 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"

Navy 4 Fabric twigs tonal

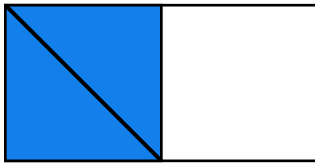
- Cut 4 squares 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"
- Cut 1 square 2" x 2"

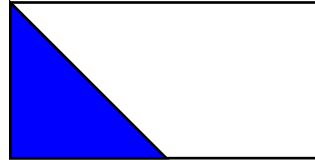

Make Flying Geese Units



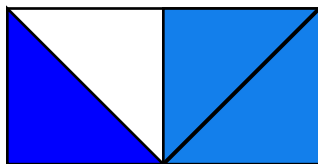
Step 1

- Draw a diagonal line on all the 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares
- Place a square, right side down, on a 4" x 2 1/4" rectangle
- Sew ON the line



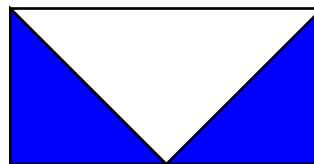
Step 2

- Flip the triangle open to the outside verify the size is 4" x 2 1/4"
- trim away the blue and white behind the flipped triangle to reduce bulk.



Step 3

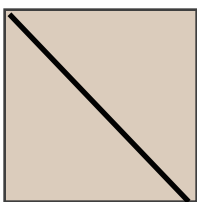
- Repeat for the other side of this rectangle.



Step 4

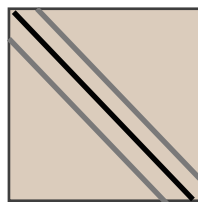
- The Flying Geese Unit measures 4" x 2 1/4"
- Make 8 Flying Geese units following quilt block for color placement.

Make 4 HST units



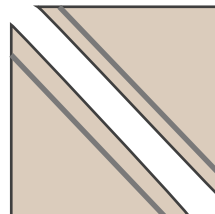
Step 1

- Draw a line on the Twig print
- 4 1/2" Squares



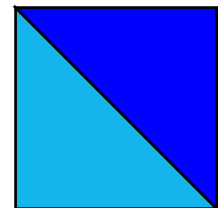
Step 2

- Layer 2 squares
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3

- Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST



- Trim squares to 4" x 4"
